If an error is made the dog may be disqualified by the Committee of The Kennel Club. ENTRIES FOR WORKING TESTS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED FROM GUNDOGS REGISTERED AT THE KENNEL CLUB IN THE GUNDOG GROUP (vide Reg. J1.a., J7a & B20) and if a registered dog has changed ownership the TRANSFER must be applied for before the closing of entries. PLEASE COMPLETE SEPARATE ENTRY FORM FOR EACH CLASS.

When entering more than one breed or variety use, if possible, a separate form for each.

If this competition is oversubscribed there will be a draw for places 10 days prior to the test date, successful applicants will be informed via email or telephone. If fees are not paid by 7 days before the event, the place will be offered to the reserve list.

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Instructions for completion of Working Test Entry Form

- Enter test venue and date in top box.

- Enter class in the class box using the following abbreviations:
 - O = Open
 - N = Novice
 - P = Puppy – any dog/bitch under 18 months on the day of the test
 - ND/NH = Novice Dog Novice Handler – Neither dog nor handler to have won a place or COM in a Field Trial or been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in an Open, Intermediate or Novice KC Working Test or 1st in a Novice Dog/Novice Handler Working Test.

- Entries to be submitted by closing date as per schedule.

- Persons entering by FTMS or sending form electronically **do not pay** on submission of form, if the competition is oversubscribed there will be a draw for places 10 days prior to the test date, successful applicants will be informed via email or telephone with instructions how to pay. Postal submissions must include a cheque for entry fees that will only be cashed if a run is accepted.

- If a draw is conducted Field Trial preferences will be allocated

- If payment is not received 7 days prior to the test, your run may be offered to the next place on the reserve list
